The third day will take us to see the Pacific at the Sonoma coast, and a visit to spectacular Redwood groves.

The driving will be easy, on roads that our Lincolns were built for. There will be no long or arduous driving days. Trailer parking will be available.

The meet package will include group dinners, some lunches, and early evening snacks and treats. There will be lots of time to visit with fellow Lincoln Owners, meet old friends and make new acquaintances.
